Scope:

This policy applies to all Wales Young Institute students.

Policy:

1. Academic dishonesty in all forms violates the basic principles of integrity and thus hinders learning.
 - a. More specifically, academic dishonesty is a form of misconduct that is subject to disciplinary action and includes the following: cheating, fabrication, fraud, facilitating academic dishonesty, and plagiarism.
2. If a student is found guilty of plagiarism or another form of academic dishonesty on course work (e.g. class paper, an exam or an assignment) an academic dishonesty report will be written for that student, and this report will be filed in the department. The student will receive a zero for the paper, the exam or the assignment.
3. If more than one academic dishonesty report has been filed for a student, the case will be presented to the School Board on Student Discipline.
